WHAT WE KNOW FROM MODERN, SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH INTO ASTROLOGY

As I see it, astrology is both an art and a science, and many astrologers today are great counselors who have mastered the art of astrological interpretation. However, astrology was also once recognized as a science, and for astrology to continue to make progress in this era of Pluto in Aquarius and Uranus in Gemini, I believe that it must establish itself, once again, as a bonafide, scientific discipline. To help astrology achieve this, I and some other researchers around the world are busily engaged in developing an evidence-based version of astrology by using tools at our disposal such as mathematics, physics, statistical analysis, and extreme case sampling. It is also important to inform the rest of the astrological community on where astrology currently stands as a scientific discipline, and so that is the purpose of this brief paper, to pass on information to you regarding the current state of the evidence for what works and what doesn't work in astrology. And the list is getting longer every day.

1. Mundane Astrology Works

The late Dr. Johnson Holt showed that **there are significantly more major news events during or in the year before outer planet conjunctions and oppositions**. A follow-up study by Robert Currey showed that **there is also an orb effect**.

2. Chart Matching Can Be Done With Help From Artificial Intelligence

Using an automated process in the program Mastro Expert that associates keywords with astrological events, **Vincent Godbout has been able to successfully match keywords associated with natal charts with keywords from biographies**, The program was given three tries to find the correct natal chart, and it was able to correctly

match charts with a significance level of p < 0.0005. The procedure was mostly automated and removed much human bias.

3. Gauquelin's Mars Effect is Real

Even though the effect size is very weak, numerous studies have shown that the Mars Effect is real, and even though the strongest level of significance was found for Mars, Gauquelin's studies also provide some confirmation for traditional associations for other planets.

Mars (energy & aggression) – eminent athletes, doctors, scientists, executives, and military personnel

Venus (art & harmony) – eminent painters and musicians

Saturn (concentration & discipline) – eminent scientists and doctors

Jupiter (expansion & other people's minds) – eminent actors, military personnel, executives, politicians, and journalists

Moon (imagination) – eminent **writers** and politicians

4. Mars and Jupiter are Extraverted and Saturn is Introverted

Using the Eysenck Personality Questionnaire, Michel Gauquelin found that ordinary people with Mars rising or culminating were significantly more likely (p=0.02) to be extroverted (E+) and tough-minded (P+) while those with the Moon rising or culminating were more likely (p=0.05) to score high on social desirability (L+). Also, Cochrane and Fink found that Mars and Jupiter are linked with extraversion and Saturn with introversion.

5. An angular Sun or Jupiter is linked with the extraversion dominant trait in dogs

Meticulous records are kept of pedigree dogs for the first two months of their lives. These records typically include birth time, birth order, and behavioral characteristics. This study of 500 pedigree dogs, done by two French scientists, categorized their behavioral traits using a method developed by Eysenck and found that **pedigree dogs** with an angular Sun or Jupiter are far more likely to exhibit the extraversion dominant trait.

6. Orbs Work

Some studies have verified traditional sizes for orbs, that orbs for applying aspects should be larger than for separating aspects, and that more major events happen while an aspect is applying rather than separating. However, some studies suggest that tight aspects are stronger while others suggest that aspects work in a binary, on/off manner. The following table is from Tarvainen, 2021.

7. Minor Aspects Work

In a study by Dr. Kyösti Tarvainen, minor aspects were shown to produce significant results, though not as strong as and with smaller orbs than major aspects. The minor aspects studied were the semisextile, decile, novile, semisquare, septile, quintile, biseptile, tridecile, sesquiquadrate, biquintile, quincunx, and the triseptile,

8. Midpoints Work

Recent studies show that **midpoints work and they clarify which aspects to midpoints are strongest.**

9. Synastry Works

Recent studies show that **synastry works even if the effect size is very small**. Less evidence exists for the effectiveness of composite and Davison charts as a measure of relationships.

10. Some House Systems Work Better Than Others

A few studies have been done on house systems, but most have not examined enough of the total number of house systems available. Nonetheless, **some of the evidence**

currently available favours Campanus, Koch, and Equal house systems, and Whole Sign Houses usually produces the worst results. However, no definitive study has yet been done that involves all of the various house systems, but ISAR, the Astrological Association, the Cosmobiology Institute, and the National Council for Geocosmic Research have all committed to work together to produce a definitive study within the next few years.

11. Progressions Work

Some studies have shown that secondary progressions have validity.

12. There is evidence that transits and solar arc progressions work

In a study by Kyösti Tarvainen, the presence of soft aspects by transit, solar arc, and secondary progressions around the time of conception were considered and **transits** and solar arcs were supported with statistical significance, but secondary progressions were not. Coupled with other evidence, this suggests that progressions work in some situations but not all.

Though the results are mixed, Tarvainen has shown that **positive signs gravitate** toward professions deemed as fitting for extraverts while negative signs prefer professions seen by psychologist as better suited for introverts.


16. The Zodiac Signs Have Meanings that Differ Slightly from Tradition

The above list summarizes an impressive amount of astrological research that has taken place over the past decade or so, and new results are appearing all the time. For example, some of my latest research shows that people born with Pluto square Uranus or Pluto square Chiron are more likely to have cancer, and men born with Chiron square or quintile Saturn are more likely to be gay and/or commit suicide. However, if you were born with any of these aspects, then keep in mind that only a small percentage of people in these groups actually develop cancer, are gay, or commit suicide. These groups are simply at greater risk for these particular outcomes.
